# Supply Nation celebrates the 2018 Supplier Diversity Awards with a live cross from the Prime Minister

Each year Supply Nation holds the Connect Gala Awards Dinner on the final night of Connect, Supply Nation's annual flagship event.

During a live cross to the event Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull said that the evening was about "Switching the narrative away from despair and deficit to one where you can say that being an Indigenous Australian means that you are successful, innovative, enterprising, realising your dreams and getting ahead. Economic empowerment is what this is all about."

At this black-tie event, the prestigious Supplier Diversity Awards are announced. This year over 850 guests attended the event at The Star Event Centre, and celebrated as the winners were revealed. The guests represented a cross-section of the 1,500 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander businesses that are listed on Indigenous Business Direct (Supply Nation's directory) and of Supply Nation's 347 members.

From the most successful organisations to the individuals who are creating change through their own advocacy or business acumen, the Supplier Diversity Awards are the highest recognition of achievement in Australian supplier diversity.

Laura Berry, CEO of Supply Nation, welcomed the guests to the Gala Awards Dinner, referencing the theme of this year's Connect: 'shaping an inclusive economy'.

"Shaping an inclusive economy is not only the theme of this year's Connect, it's also at the heart of everything we do at Supply Nation. We believe that if we all work together we can achieve a more inclusive economy, where all Australians have equal opportunities," Ms Berry said.

"Supplier diversity is an inclusive practice. Everyone from CEOs to procurement specialists; from start-ups to successful enterprises; from advocates to entrepreneurs with big ideas: must work together to build a truly inclusive economy for all Australians."

Ms Berry continued "Tonight is about recognising the organisations and individuals who are leading the way in supplier diversity. Tonight is about identifying and rewarding excellence, so we can continue to set the bar higher.
