2021 Supplier Diversity Award winners announced at Supply Nation's flagship event

Last week, Supply Nation hosted Australia's leading supplier diversity event, Connect, to unite Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander businesses, corporate organisations and government departments from across the nation.

Hosted by Stan Grant, the two-day broadcast event included a Knowledge Forum with a spectacular line up of speakers including author Anita Heiss, Supply Nation Chief Executive Officer, Laura Berry, Managing Director of Microsoft Australia, Steven Worrall, and Managing Director of Tourism Australia, Phillipa Harrison, as well as a Tradeshow featuring over 90 Indigenous exhibitors and concluded with an Awards Show hosted by Brooke Boney and Aaron Fa'Aoso.

Highlights from the Supplier Diversity Awards included Leah Cameron for taking home both Indigenous Businesswoman of the Year and Certified Supplier of the Year on behalf of her business Marrawah Law, as well as JLL for winning Corporate Member of the Year and the Outstanding Impact Award.

Supply Nation's Chief Executive Officer, Laura Berry, says "After a very challenging year for the sector, Connect 2021 was able to bring together the supplier diversity community to celebrate their resilience and achievements.

"Not only did we hear from some of Australia's leading supplier diversity and business experts, but we were also able to engage our Indigenous businesses and showcase the diversity and vibrancy of their products and services and foster business opportunities through the Tradeshow element.

"The announcement of the Supplier Diversity Award winners concluded the powerful two-day event, and I would like to give a sincere congratulations to all of the winners in recognition of their leadership in supplier diversity in Australia.

Ms Berry also announced in her keynote address a new milestone for Supply Nation: "Since 2009, Supply Nation has been the first and pre-eminent supplier diversity organisation in Australia.
