From agile sole-traders to multi-million-dollar operations, the Tradeshow is a hub where passionate entrepreneurs and buyers from across the country will come together and reconnect under the same roof.

The event will conclude with the Gala Awards Dinner, hosted by renowned journalist, author and filmmaker **Stan Grant**. The awards dinner will run from 6:00pm – late and will bring together the Indigenous business sector to recognise the achievements of outstanding individuals and organisations at the Supplier Diversity Awards 2022. Guests from across the globe will gather to celebrate the success within the Australian supplier diversity community and culminate with fantastic live performances.
