Finalists announced for Supply Nation's Supplier Diversity Awards 2023

Supply Nation is thrilled to announce the finalists for this year's **Supplier Diversity Awards**. The Supplier Diversity Awards recognise companies, government agencies, not-for-profit organisations and individuals who are helping create a prosperous, vibrant and sustainable Indigenous business sector.

Supply Nation CEO, Michelle Deshong, said "The Supplier Diversity Awards provide an occasion for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander businesses, as well as member organisations, to be recognised for their achievements and to celebrate their success alongside their team, business partners, family, peers and community."

The finalists for this year's awards were selected by an independent judging panel drawn from business leaders and procurement specialists across the Indigenous business sector. The sheer volume of submissions – which saw a 30% increase from 2022 – along with the strength of each nomination, provides a shining example of the Indigenous business sector's continued growth and the prosperous, equitable, sustainable future it is helping to create for First Nations peoples.

The winners of the Supplier Diversity Awards will be announced at the **Connect 2023 Gala Awards Dinner**, taking place on Gadigal Land at the ICC Sydney on **Tuesday 8 August**. Hosted by Whadjuk Noongar journalist, presenter and commentator, Narelda Jacobs and Wiradjuri theatre, film and television performer, Luke Carroll, the dinner will bring together the Indigenous business sector to celebrate the achievements of outstanding individuals and organisations, with performances from First Nations artists.

Connect is Supply Nation's annual flagship event for the Indigenous business sector that brings together Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander businesses, corporate organisations and government departments to foster new business opportunities and celebrate the success of the sector.

The theme for this year's event – **Empowering Indigenous Futures** – acknowledges the significant political, social and economic changes that have led to greater outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
