In 2024, Supply Nation proudly celebrates 15 years of working to grow the Indigenous business sector. The milestone is testament to the significant contribution of Indigenous businesses to the Australian economy, a contribution that Supply Nation has been instrumental in fostering.

Registration of the 5,000<sup>th</sup> business, Arnya Consulting, has been finalised, and details are available through Supply Nation's public database, Indigenous Business Direct (IBD).

Arnya Consulting is a business solutions provider specialising in bridging the distance between urban and remote areas by blending Indigenous knowledge with cutting-edge digital solutions. Based in Weipa, in Queensland's Cape York Peninsula, Arnya Consulting is dedicated to creating opportunities that value Indigenous knowledge and help businesses connect authentically with Indigenous communities.

Indigenous businesses are active in every sector of the Australian economy. Supply Nation's database contains businesses operating in agribusiness, food and beverages, construction, engineering and professional services, logistics and transport, hospitality and training, tourism, energy and resources, aerospace, satellite services, creative industries as well as cybersecurity and data protection.

"The diversity of the Indigenous business sector cannot be underestimated. In the year 2022/2023, Supply Nation facilitated and enabled \$4.1 billion of spend with verified Indigenous suppliers.

"The Indigenous business sector is growing from strength to strength, and we will see that represented at our Connect 2024 event this year and reflected in our Supplier Diversity Awards. Australia is starting to fully appreciate how deadly Indigenous-owned business can be, here in this country, and in our international markets," said Ms Russell.

Connect 2024 will for the first time be held in Meanjin on the lands of the Turrbal and Jagera peoples at the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre on Wednesday 28 August and Thursday 29 August 2024.

Over 2,000 participants are expected to attend the Connect 2024 Knowledge Forum, Indigenous Business Tradeshow and Gala Awards Dinner.
